Summarized From RULES OF ELECTION (PETITION)

One (1) Member is to be elected from among the active members of the Police Department of the rank of Sergeant.

The Petition of each candidate for Member must be signed by at least twenty five (25) persons duly qualified to vote for **Sergeant's Representative** of the rank of Sergeant, available for pick-up at the Fund office September 1-26, 2011.

The Petitions of Candidates must be filed during the period of September 27, 2011 through October 3, 2011, both dates inclusive, at the Office of the Retirement Board, 221 N. LaSalle Street, Room 1626, from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

The Sufficiency of any Petitions may be challenged in writing up to and including October 4, 2011.

Any Candidate may withdraw his Petition on or before October 5, 2011.

The sufficiency of all nominating Petitions shall be passed upon by the Retirement Board on October 6, 2011.

No Candidates name shall be printed on the ballot unless he has filed a Petition.

One (1) Member is to be elected from among the active members of the Police Department of the rank of **Lieutenant or rank superior to Lieutenant**.

The Petition of each candidate for Member must be signed by at least twenty five (25) persons duly qualified to vote for Lieutenant's Representative of the rank Lieutenant or rank superior to Lieutenant, available for pick-up at the Fund office September 1-26, 2011.

The Petitions of Candidates must be filed during the period of September 27, 2011 through October 3, 2011, both dates inclusive, at the Office of the Retirement Board, 221 N. LaSalle Street, Room 1626, from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

The Sufficiency of any Petitions may be challenged in writing up to and including October 4, 2011.

Any Candidate may withdraw his Petition on or before October 5, 2011.

The sufficiency of all nominating Petitions shall be passed upon by the Retirement Board on October 6, 2011.

No Candidates name shall be printed on the ballot unless he has filed a Petition.
