

NOTICE OF ELECTION

The Retirement Board of the Policemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund will be holding an election on October 27, 2011, which will be conducted by mail. There are two trustee positions up for election this year. The representative for the Sergeants as well as the elected representative for those holding the civil service rank of Lieutenant and above, are up for election to three year terms beginning December 1, 2011 until November 30, 2014.

Active and disabled officers in these specific ranks are eligible to run for the election and are encouraged to pick up petitions for elected trustee at the Pension Fund office, located at 221 N. LaSalle, Suite 1626, Chicago, IL. 60601 beginning September 1, 2011 between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE THE CANDIDATE DESIRING TO RUN MUST BE THE PERSON PICKING UP AS WELL AS TURNING IN THE SIGNED PETITIONS.

Also, please note a candidate for Sergeant must turn in 25 Sergeant signatures and the candidate for the Lieutenant and Above trustee position must obtain 25 signatures of those in the civil service title of Lieutenant and Above as well.

Please note the candidates petitions for the trustee election are due to be turned in between September 27 and October 3, close of business (COB). The first candidate to file petitions will be placed first on the ballot so if ballot position is of importance to you, plan on turning in the petitions as soon as possible, which is 9 a.m. on September 27, 2011. If more than one candidate is here at the same time on the 27th of September a lottery draw will determine ballot position.
